



Braille Sense Plus



The Braille Sense Plus is an advanced Notetaker. It has a Perkins-style Braille keyboard or a Qwerty keyboard, a Braille display and an audio output. It has an ergonomic design and runs from a battery, so ideal for taking along. The Braille version has a built-in LCD display that enables sighted people like parents and teachers to see the text in real-time. Both versions have a VGA output that can connect to an external monitor.



The Braille Sense Plus has the following software built-in:
Context-sensitive Help features, Word processor, File manager, Address manager, Schedule manager, E-mail, Web browser, Media player, Daisy player, Bluetooth manager, MSN messenger, Database manager, Calculator, Wakeup alarm, Calendar, Stopwatch, Terminal for screen reader, backup/restore. Additionally the units have a Radio built-in.
